Subject: REACH - Registration & Intended Uses.

Dear Sir/Madam,

On the 1st June 2007, new European legislation on the safe use of chemicals substances, better known as Reach, came into force. The pre-registration phase of chemical substances being produced or imported into the EU ended on the 1st December 2008. After this deadline, chemical substances that have not been pre-registered may no longer be used within the EU.

Since the pre-registration, the Reach registration phase has been underway for almost a year.

INTENDED USES

During this phase, manufacturers or importers (direct or indirect Corus suppliers) will have to prepare the Exposure Scenarios and Extended Material Safety Data Sheets, and as such, need to identify the INTENDED USES by their customers (Downstream Users). To include this information in the chemical substance registration dossier, suppliers need to know these intended uses at least 12 months before the final registration date of the 1st December 2010.

To allow us to determine that our application (Intended Use) of your products matches the standard Intended Uses that your company have identified, we kindly request that you inform us accordingly.

REGISTRATION

Most manufacturers and importers should know which chemical substances they will register. For Corus as an end-user this information can be important. We therefore request that you inform us separately per substance that your company supply, and please confirm if the manufacturer or importer will register in accordance with the Reach legislation.
